DAY 02 PRAGUE

(Meals on Board/Dinner)

Prague, capital of the Czech Republic. Lying at the heart of Europe, it is one of the continent's finest cities and the major Czech economic and cultural centre.

St. Vitus Cathedral, the largest and the most important cathedral in Prague.



Prague Castle, a castle complex in Prague, Czech Republic, built in the 9th century. It is the official office of the President of the Czech Republic.

Old Royal Palace, part of the Prague Castle complex, which served as a residence of princes until the 16th century.



Charles Bridge, a medieval stone arch bridge that crosses the Vltava River in Prague, Czech Republic.

Astronomical Clock, a medieval artifact that has been functioning for almost 600 years and is one of the world's greatest and most unique clocks.

DAY 04 PRAGUE 🚗 CESKY KRUMLOV 🚗 SALZBURG

(Breakfast/Dinner)

Cesky Krumlov, UNESCO World Heritage Site. One of the Czech Republic's finest medieval sites. Its Old Town is a maze of twisting alleys built around the extensive Cesky Krumlov castle.

Optional: Hallstatt

Hallstatt, an UNESCO World Heritage sites. Known as "the most Instagrammable town in the world".



Accommodation: Austria Trend Europa or similar

DAY 05 SALZBURG 🚗 VIENNA

(Breakfast/Dinner)

Salzburg, a city situated in a level basin on both sides of the Salzach River near the northern foothills of the Alps and the German border.



Mirabell Garden, a beautiful sight with flowers and statues from the Greek mythology. Today, Mirabell palace houses the offices of the mayor of Salzburg and the town council.

No. 9 Getreidegasse, was the birthplace of Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart.

Old Town, one of the best-preserved city centres north of the Alps. Famous for its baroque architecture, alpine setting and picturesque location on the Salzach River, Salzburg and its historic centre charms and delights many visitors.

Optional: Vienna Concert Orchestra

Vienna Concert Orchestra, the program consists mostly of music by Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart. For example, "Don Giovanni", The Marriage of Figaro", The Magic Flute or "A little Night Music".



Accommodation: Renaissance Vienna (G) or similar

DAY 06 VIENNA 🚗 PARNDORF 🚗 BRATISLAVA

(Breakfast/Lunch)

Vienna, the capital of Austria. Of the country's nine states, Vienna is the smallest in area but the largest in population.

Schonbrunn Palace, was the main summer residence of the Habsburg rulers, located in Hietzing, Vienna.



Ringstrasse, is 5.3 kilometers long, enough to provide space for numerous monumental buildings, from **State Opera house, Reichsrat**

Parliament Building, Rathaus, and Hofburg Imperial Palace.

St. Stephen's Cathedral, the symbol of Vienna. Construction commenced in the 12th century. Today, it is one of the most important Gothic structures in Austria.



Designer Outlet Parndorf, the designer stores always at up to 30 to 70% less. Its beautiful setting is inspired by traditional Austrian architecture with cafes and restaurants as well as a children's play area

Schonbrunn Palace, one of Austria's most important cultural assets, and since the 1960s has been one of Vienna's major tourist



attractions, drawing millions of visitors each year.

DAY 07 BRATISLAVA 🚆 BUDAPEST

(Breakfast/Lunch)

Bratislava, in southwestern Slovakia at the foot of the Little Carpathians, occupying both banks of the river Danube and the left bank of the river Morava.



Old Town, a historic center and one of the boroughs of Bratislava, in the Bratislava Region of Slovakia.



Bratislava Castle, the landmark overlooking the Capital, was built in the 9th century. As an age-long symbol of the city, it proudly stands

on the hill above Danube River.

Grassalkovich Palace, a palace in Bratislava and the residence of the president of Slovakia. The building is a Rococo - late Baroque summer palace with a French garden.

Primate's Palace, a neo-Classical palace in Bratislava's Old Town.

Budapest, city and capital of Hungary, and seat of Pest county. The city is the political, administrative, industrial, and commercial centre of Hungary.



Heroes' Square, one of the major squares in Budapest, Hungary, noted for its iconic **Millennium Monument** with statues featuring the Seven chieftains of the Magyars and other important Hungarian national leaders, as well as the Memorial Stone of Heroes, often erroneously referred to as the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier.

St Stephen's Basilica, a Roman Catholic Basilica in Budapest, Hungary. It was the sixth largest church building in Hungary before 1920.



Fisherman's Bastion, Resplendent with turrets and towers that resemble a fairytale, the Fisherman's Bastion is one of the city's most iconic sites and has 7 towers in all, each representing one of Hungary's tribes.

Gellert Hill, is a 235m high hill overlooking the Danube in Budapest, Hungary.




Vaci Street, one of the main pedestrian thoroughfares and perhaps the most famous street of central Budapest, Hungary.
