DAY 01 SINGAPORE ✈ PRAGUE / MUNICH

(Meals on Board)

Assemble at Changi airport and take off to the capital city of **Czech Republic, Prague** or the Capital of Bavaria, **Munich**.

DAY 02 PRAGUE

(Meals on Board/Dinner)

Prague, capital of the Czech Republic. Lying at the heart of Europe, it is one of the continent's finest cities and the major Czech economic and cultural centre.

St. Vitus Cathedral, the largest and the most important cathedral in Prague.

Prague Castle, a castle complex in Prague, Czech Republic, built in the 9th century. It is the official office of the President of the

Czech Republic.

Old Royal Palace, part of the Prague Castle complex, which served as a residence of princes until the 16th century.



Charles Bridge, a medieval stone arch bridge that crosses the Vltava River in Prague, Czech Republic.

Astronomical Clock, a medieval artifact that has been functioning for almost 600 years and is one of the world's greatest and most unique clocks.



Wenceslas Square, a city square in the centre of Prague is a traditional venue for celebrations, demonstrations, and public gatherings.

DAY 03 PRAGUE-FREE DAY

(Breakfast)

Free at leisure for some shopping or sight-seeing in Prague.

Optional: Cesky Krumlov

Cesky Krumlov, an **UNESCO World Heritage site**. One of the Czech Republic's finest medieval sites. Its Old Town is a maze of twisting alleys built around the extensive Cesky Krumlov castle.

Accommodation: Clarion Congress or similar

DAY 04 PRAGUE 🚗 DRESDEN 🚗 BERLIN

(Breakfast/Lunch/Pork Knuckle Dinner with Beer)

Dresden, the traditional capital of Saxony and the third largest city in eastern Germany after Berlin and Leipzig.

Semper Opera House, the most famous opera house in Germany; it houses the Saxon State Orchestra, one of the world's oldest and best-known orchestras.

Zwinger Palace, a landmark building featuring fine architecture, interesting museums, lovely gardens, gorgeous pavilions, and picturesque fountains.

Frauenkirche, literally translates as the Church of Our Lady, which is in Dresden, the capital of the German state of Saxony.

Furstenzug, a large mural of a mounted procession of the rulers of Saxony.



Bruhlsche Terrasse, a renaissance terrace nicknamed "The Balcony of Europe", running along the river with sweeping views.

Optional: Bastei

Bastei, a rock formation rising 194 metres above the Elbe River in the Elbe Sandstone Mountains of Germany. Reaching a height of 305 metres above sea level, the jagged rocks of the Bastei were formed by water erosion over one million years ago.

Accommodation: Wyndham Garden Berlin Mitte or similar

DAY 05 BERLIN 🚗 WROCLAW

(Breakfast/Dinner)

Berlin, the capital and largest city of Germany by both area and population.

Brandenburg Gate, an 18th-century



neoclassical monument in Berlin, built on the orders of Prussian king Frederick William II after restoring the Orangist power by suppressing the Dutch popular unrest.



Reichstag, the Parliament house. One of Berlin's most famous landmarks, it is situated at the northern end of the Ebertstrasse and near the south bank of the Spree River.

East Side Gallery, a 1.3-kilometre-long painted stretch of the former Berlin Wall along Mühlenstraße in former East Berlin.

Berlin Wall, a guarded concrete barrier that physically and ideologically divided Berlin from 1961 to 1989 as well as encircling and separating West Berlin from East German territory.

Check-point Charlie, the Landmark boundary marking east & west Berlin with a white sentry guard house & cobbled border line.

Accommodation: Novotel Wroclaw Centrum or similar

DAY 06 WROCLAW 🚗 AUSCHWITZ 🚗 KRAKOW

(Breakfast/Dinner)

Wroclaw, a remarkable area filled with Baroque splendor that was painfully reconstructed after WWII.

Main Market Square, the second largest in Poland, after that in Krakow. It is a medieval market square, now the heart of a

pedestrian zone.

Cathedral Island, the seat of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Wroclaw and a landmark of the city of Wroclaw in Poland.

Centennial Hall, an **UNESCO World Heritage site**. It was constructed according to the plans of architect Max Berg in 1911–1913, when the city was part of the German Empire.

Auschwitz Concentration Camp, which was Nazi Germany's concentration camps and the establishment of the main extermination camp. In 2007, **UNESCO** named the camp "**Auschwitz - Birkenau German Nazi concentration and extermination camp (1940-1945)**".



Accommodation: Doubletree by Hilton Hotel Convention Centre or similar

DAY 07 KRAKOW

(Breakfast/Dinner)

Kraków, one of the largest cities in Poland, city and capital of Malopolskie province, southern Poland, lying on both sides of the upper Vistula River.

Wawel Royal Castle, a castle residency located in central Kraków, Poland. Built at the behest of King Casimir III the Great, it consists of several structures from different periods situated around the Italian-styled main courtyard.

St. Mary's Basilica, a Brick Gothic church adjacent to the Main Market

Square in Kraków, Poland.

Cloth Hall, or Sukiennice is a medieval market building in Krakow, Poland.



Wieliczka Salt Mine, an **UNESCO World Heritage site**. One of the world's oldest operating salt mines, excavated from the 13th century, produced table salt continuously until 2007.

Accommodation: Doubletree by Hilton Hotel Convention Centre or similar

DAY 08 KRAKOW 🚗 DONOVALY 🚗 BUDAPEST

(Breakfast/Hungarian Folk Show Dinner)

Head on a scenic drive by crossing over the border into **Slovakia** to wind through **Donovaly** and past the Tatra Mountains, towards to capital of **Hungary, Budapest**.

Accommodation: Park Inn by Radisson or similar

DAY 09 BUDAPEST

(Breakfast/Danube Cruise Lunch)

Budapest, city and capital of Hungary, and seat of Pest county. The city is the political, administrative, industrial, and commercial centre of Hungary.

Heroes' Square, one of the major squares in Budapest, Hungary, noted for its iconic **Millennium Monument** with statues featuring the Seven chieftains of the Magyars and other important Hungarian national leaders, as well as the Memorial Stone of Heroes, often erroneously referred as the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier.



St Stephen's Basilica, a Roman Catholic Basilica in Budapest, Hungary. It was the sixth largest church building in Hungary before 1920.

Fisherman's Bastion, resplendent with turrets and towers that resemble a fairytale, the Fisherman's Bastion is one of the city's most iconic sites and has 7 towers in

all, each representing one of Hungary's tribes.

Gellert Hill, is a 235m high hill overlooking the Danube in Budapest, Hungary.



Vaci Street, one of the main pedestrian thoroughfares and perhaps the most famous street of central Budapest, Hungary.

DAY 10 BUDAPEST 🚗 BRATISLAVA 🚗 PARNDORF 🚗 VIENNA

(Breakfast/Lunch)

Bratislava, in southwestern Slovakia at the foot of the Little Carpathians, occupying both banks of the river Danube and the left bank of the river Morava.

Old Town, a historic center and one of the boroughs of Bratislava, in the Bratislava Region of Slovakia.



Bratislava Castle, the landmark overlooking the Capital, was built in the 9th century. As an age-long symbol of the city, it proudly stands on the hill above Danube River.

Grassalkovich Palace, a palace in Bratislava and the residence of the president of Slovakia. The building is a Rococo-late Baroque summer palace with a French garden.

Primate's Palace, a neo-Classical palace in Bratislava's Old Town.

Designer Outlet Parndorf, the designer stores always at up to 30 to 70% less. Its beautiful setting is inspired by traditional Austrian architecture with cafes and restaurants as well as a children's play area

DAY 11 VIENNA

(Breakfast/Vienna Ribs Lunch)

Vienna, the capital of Austria. Of the country's nine states, Vienna is the smallest in area but the largest in population.

Schonbrunn Palace, one of Austria's most important cultural assets, and since the 1960s has been one of Vienna's major tourist attractions, drawing millions of visitors each year.

Ringstrasse, Vienna's Ringstrasse is 5.3 kilometers long. Long enough to provide space for numerous monumental

buildings, from **State Opera house**, **Reichsrat Parliament Building**, **Rathaus**, and **Hofburg Imperial Palace**.

St. Stephen's Cathedral, the symbol of Vienna. Construction commenced in the 12th century. Today, it is one of the most important Gothic structures in Austria.

Seegrotte, a piece of extraordinary mining history and be enchanted by a mysterious labyrinth of tunnels and underground passages as well as an unforgettable boat trip on Europe's largest underground.

DAY 12 VIENNA 🚗 **HALLSTATT** 🚗 **SALZBURG**

(Breakfast/Chinese Dinner)

Hallstatt, an **UNESCO World Heritage site**. Known as "the most Instagrammable town

in the world".

Salzburg, a city situated in a level basin on both sides of the Salzach River near the northern foothills of the Alps and the German border.

Mirabell Garden, a beautiful sight with flowers and statues from the Greek mythology. Today, Mirabell palace houses the offices of the mayor of Salzburg and the town council.



No. 9 Getreidegasse, was the birthplace of Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart

Old Town, one of the best-preserved city centres north of the Alps. Famous for its baroque architecture, alpine setting and picturesque location on the Salzach River, Salzburg and its historic centre charms and delights many visitors.

Wattens, stop by the **Swarovski Crystal World**, a glittering fantasy world housing the world's biggest crystal. Swarovski partnered with Disney to create the famous crystal shoe for the 2015's Cinderella movie.



Fussen, sightseeing at **Neuschwanstein Castle**, a fairy-tale fortress built for an introverted and reclusive king, Neuschwanstein Castle was built in the 19th century for Bavaria's notorious King Ludwig II and is now a prominent tourist attraction which draws vast numbers of visitors every year.
